



Whew! I've registered!

Now what happens?

When are the teams assigned?

Your AYSO 390 Board and Coaches begin the process of putting the teams together for the upcoming season right away. Coaches will get their team rosters at the Coach meeting on **Monday, February 21st**.

When do the players get called?

The Coaches will call all their players between **February 21st-26th**. Your Coach will give you all the information you will need about practice times and location. Teams may begin practice on or after **February 28th**. Each coach sets his/her own practice days, time, and location. The practice fields are located throughout Oak Ridge. Your field may not be the closest one to your home.

It's after February 26th and my child has not been called. What do I do?

Please don't panic if you see teams practicing and your child has not been called. Not all teams begin practice at the same time. What else does my child need?

Your registration fee includes all AYSO fees, field maintenance and equipment costs, goals, nets, accident insurance, and City fees. Uniforms can be used for many years, so the cost is not included in the registration fee. Uniforms can be purchased at the AYSO office during registration. All players must wear the full AYSO Region 390 uniform in games. Your child may also need soccer cleats, a soccer ball (size depends on age), and a water bottle.

How often are practices and games?

U5 and U6 teams practice once a week and play their games during their practice time. U8-U19 teams usually practice twice a week (field and times are determined by your child's coach). Games will be on Saturdays. The first game is scheduled for **March 12th**.

Refunds

Players withdrawing prior to **February 28th** will be issued a full refund. After that, \$25.00 is charged to cover fees that have already been paid to National AYSO and the City of Oak Ridge. **No refunds** are issued after the season begins except if: 1) a child is injured and unable to play; or 2) a child has moved out of the region. **Please contact the registrar at 368-0915 or registrarR390@comcast.net to request a refund.**

Late registration

Players who register after February 12th will be put on a waiting list and will be placed on a team if space permits. Late Registration Fee is \$15.00. Your check is deposited only if the child is assigned a team. To check on late registration possibility, call 865-368-0915.
